Itinerary:

Day 0	Assemble at Kachiguda Railway Station Board train to Madanapalle - 3-tier AC or by road AC Bus
Day 1	Arrive at Madanapalle station by early morning. Transfer to Horsley Hills (27kms) Resort check-in & allotment, followed by breakfast at the hotel. Team Briefing Ice Breaker activity and exploring Horsly Hills Buffet Lunch Adventure activities – Zipline and Valley crossing Buffet dinner at the Hotel with campfire and music Overnight stay at hotel
Day 2	Early morning Hike to the highest point of Horsley Hills Breakfast Visit to Forest Environmental Centre and briefing Scavenger Hunt – game Fun activities followed by Lunch at the Resort Adventure activities – Rappelling and Valley crossing DJ Night Dinner & overnight stay at the resort

Day 3	Early wake-up, Trekking, and Cave exploration Breakfast at the resort Community Outreach Activity – Reduce, Recycle and Reuse <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Poster Making with school name • Plant a Sapling • Bird Feeder-making & Water feeder for animals • Participation certificate from AP Tourism and Forest Department • Lunch at the Resort Visit a Nearby village. Evening Snacks at the Village Visit the process of making mulberry silk fabric and weaving sarees. (Madanpalle is famous for silk sarees) Dinner & Board train to Secunderabad
Day 4	Reach Secunderabad Railway station.
